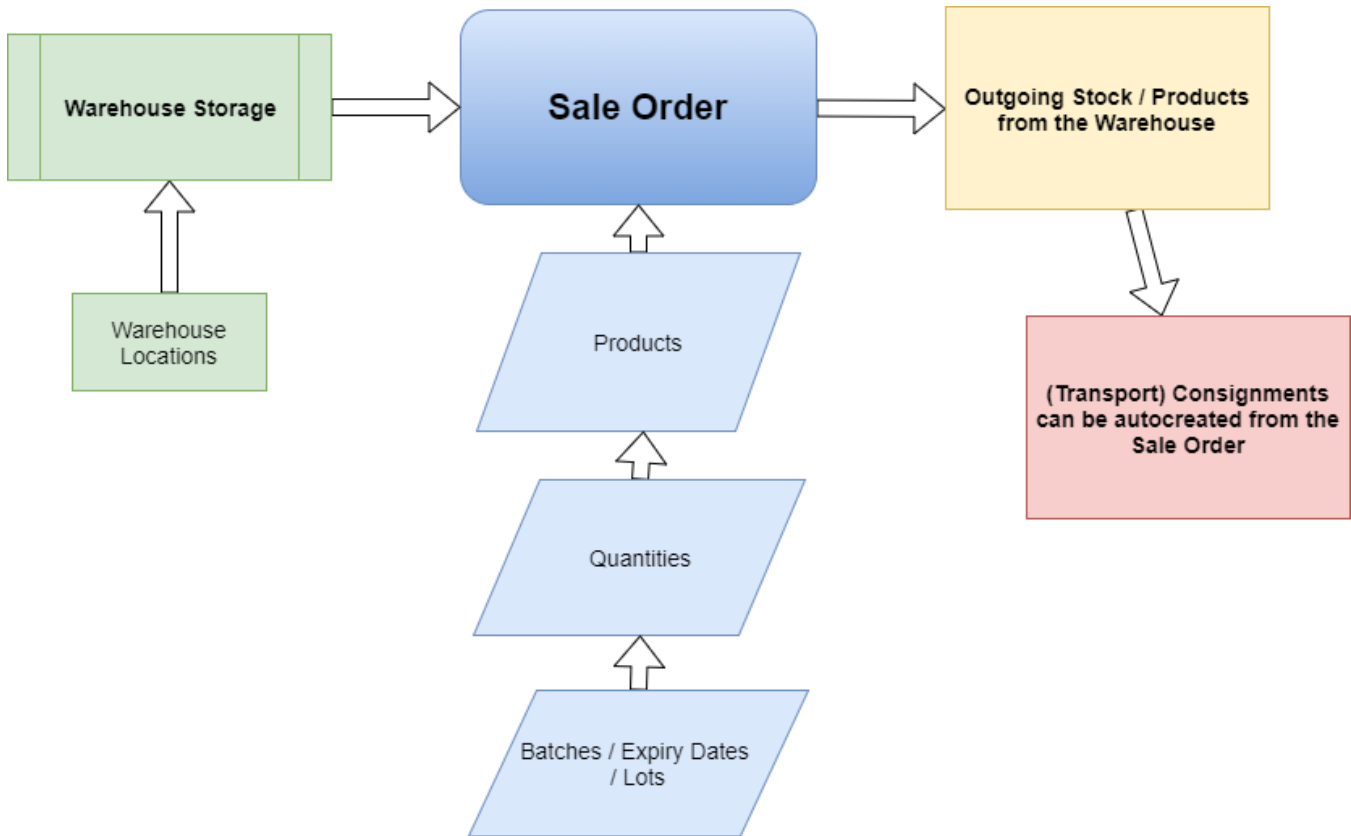

Sale Order Key Points

- All stock leaving the warehouse must have a Sale Order at the same time this is so storage can be processed accurately and transport jobs created if setup.
- They can be entered directly by your team, by customers through their login ([Users](#)), automatically by [Parsers](#) or by the [Legacy API](#)
- Controls over what needs to be entered in Sale Orders and how, can be found through the [Customer Settings](#)
- Pick/Pack can be done individually or by grouping the Sale Orders into [Wave Picking](#)
